Select Column A or B below, and answer all questions in that column. Remember we don't know you, and you're competing with overachievers. Your answers need to show us you're the kind of person we want to win our scholarship. \$2,000 for an RHS senior.

Column A

1. Show us something original you've created.

2. In no more than three sentences, compare and contrast a recent movie remake/reboot with the original. For example, *Star Trek II: The Wrath of Khan* was a multi-layered exploration of the universal themes that have fascinated humanity since the dawn of time, replete with allusions to classic literature. *Star Trek Into Darkness* was a rumination on how hard the world's greatest intellectuals can punch each other.

3. If we wanted to learn absolutely nothing about an applicant, what would be a good question to ask?

4. Describe yourself with a plausible superlative in one sentence. For example, I would say "Of all RHS scholarship applications, I make the best use of basic features in PowerPoint." You might say "I am the most observant flautist this side of the Mississippi."

Column B

1. *WHO DO YOU THINK YOU ARE?*

2. In no more than three sentences, what do you think will be Shia LaBeouf's enduring legacy?

3. Briefly describe one thing you've done that's unlike you, but in a roundabout way says a lot about you.

4. If you could bring overwhelming shame on your family, your community, and everyone who has ever known you, how would you want to do it? For example, you might say "Start a fight as I'm losing the Super Bowl," or "Try to burn down the moon."

Whichever column you choose, Question 1 is the most important. Your answers should say a lot about who you are. A personal answer is usually better than an academic one, and it doesn't have to be written. Videos, music, pictures, non-perishable food items, and robots are all acceptable. Please don't mention Miley Cyrus or Aristophanes; we've heard enough about them. We really don't care about speeding tickets at all. The 2015 Clambake Society Scholarship is a one-time \$2000 scholarship to be awarded to a Rhinelander High School senior graduating in the 2014-2015 school year.
